1760 1765 1770 1775 1780 1785 1790

Edward Tyler Sr (1719-1802) and wife Anne Langley settle in Louisville.

Edward Tyler acquires 500 acres on Chenoweth Run and 503 acres in 1787

1792 Edward Tyler's son, Moses, acquires 220 acres of his father's land, begins construction of stone cottage, barn, and spring house.

1779 Town of Louisville is created by the Va. legislature

The pop. of Ky. Territory is 61,133 white, 12,430 enslaved, 114 emancipated
