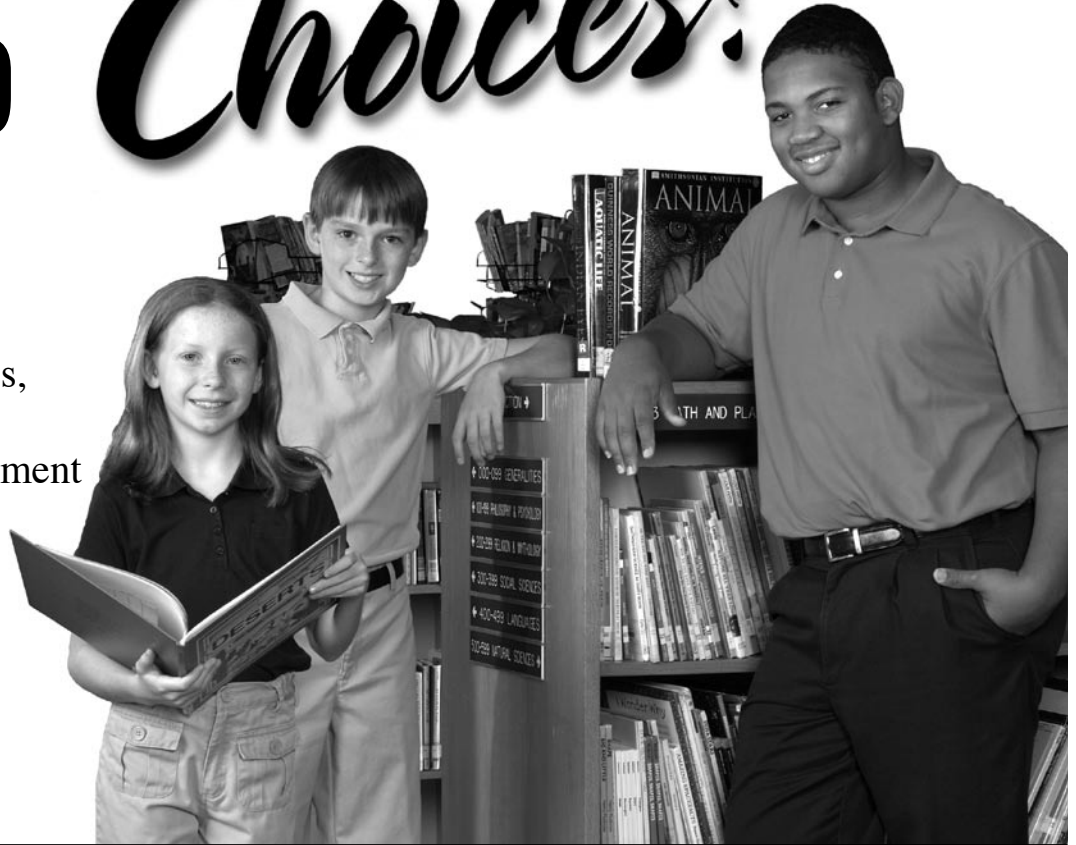

Procedures for Middle and High School Applicants

1. Read the application carefully.
2. **Submit only one application. If you submit more than one, the second will cancel the first, which could jeopardize acceptance into a program.**
3. Fill in all the information requested on the application. Blank spaces could slow the acceptance process.
4. For most schools, you may select as many as two choices. If you make more than two choices, we cannot process the application. You should not list a traditional school, the Brown School, or a middle school Math/Science/Technology (MST) program as a second choice. These programs and schools use a random-draw list process. A student will be included on a random-draw list only if the program or the school is indicated as the student's first choice and the application is submitted by the deadline.
5. Do not use post office box numbers for the student's address. We cannot process box numbers.
6. The JCPS Optional, Magnet, and Advance Programs Office must receive your completed application by 5 p.m. on **Fri., Jan. 4, 2008**. The office does not consider postmarks when it processes applications. Neither the date nor the order in which the office receives applications will be a factor in the selection of students for programs. Mail your application—if you're sure it will arrive in time to meet the deadline—to the following address:

7. The office will confirm that it has received your application by mailing a postcard. If you don't get this postcard within three weeks after you submit your application, please call the office at **485-3323**.
8. For information on any additional application requirements at the schools to which you apply, read the "To apply" section in each school's listing in the guidebook.
9. If the school to which you're applying needs additional application information or materials (progress reports, test scores, portfolios, essays, etc.), you will receive a letter from the school explaining how the additional information should be submitted. Do not mail any additional information with your application form to the Optional, Magnet, and Advance Programs Office.
10. After you are notified of acceptance into a program or school, contact the JCPS Department of Transportation at **485-3470** for bus schedule information.
11. If you have any questions about the application process, please call the Optional, Magnet, and Advance Programs Office at **485-3323**.

Applicants who are not residents of Jefferson County will not be considered for school placement until all Jefferson County applicants have been considered. Applicants whose parents are moving into Jefferson County from another county or another state may apply but must provide proof of residence in Jefferson County before enrollment.
