2009-2010 Restricted Dress Code

Pants/Slacks

- Solid-color, must be cotton/permanent press. No different-color pockets, flaps or logos are allowed. No denim pants (jeans) are allowed.
- Must be ankle-length.
- No logos or markings are allowed on pants, except Waggener school, team or club logos approved by the Administration.
- No spandex or sweatpants are allowed, except Waggener school, team or club apparel approved by the Administration.
- Must be worn at waist level.
- No cuts or slashes will be allowed in pants/slacks, including manufactured slits.
- No shorts, skirts or capri pants will be allowed.

Shirts

- Must be collared, polo-style shirts or collared, cotton/oxford cloth dress shirts. Short or long sleeves are allowed and must be buttoned appropriately.
- No markings or writings (except manufacturer logos no larger than 2" x 2") are allowed on shirts.
- Waggener school, team or club logos on shirts approved by the Administration are allowed.
- Waggener school, team or club T-Shirts approved by the Administration are allowed.
- No skin may be showing around the waist area.

Shoes

- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- Shoes must have a closed toe and a solid heel. No sandals, flip-flops, shower shoes, or house shoes will be allowed.
- Shoestrings will match each other as well as shoe color.

Sweaters/Sweatshirts/Hoodies

- Only Waggener school, team or club sweaters/sweatshirts/hoodies approved by the Administration are allowed.
- Sweaters/sweatshirts/hoodies may not be worn tied around the waist or carried by any student. If not being worn, those items must be placed in a locker.

Outerwear

- Outerwear, except any Waggener school, team or club outerwear approved by the Administration is not allowed and must be removed upon entering the building.
- Outerwear, except as noted above, must be placed in a locker by 7:35am and may not be carried with a student. All said outerwear must be secured in student's locker and remain there until dismissal at 2:20pm.
- No blankets, of any kind, are allowed to be worn or carried by any student.

Waggener Dress Code also prohibits the following during school hours:

- Hats, caps, hoods, bandanas, sweatbands, combs, or any other head apparel may not be worn in the school building at any time.
- Students may not wear gloves or sunglasses within the building.
- Students may not wear any spiked or studded bracelets/necklaces. Students are also not allowed to wear wallet chains.
- Chains, necklaces and lanyards must be worn inside of shirts.
- Belts and buckles must be of standard size (not to exceed two inches).
- The Administrative staff has the authority to regulate student dress, wearing apparel, and school accessories to ensure student safety. The administrative staff may restrict any item that distracts from the learning environment.
- The Administration shall have the right to waive any dress code restriction due to a bona-fide religious practice or for medical reasons.

This Dress Code is reviewed by the SBDM Council during the year and the Dress Code may be modified as needed. The Administration shall be the sole and final authority to decide any dress code issue/interpretation. Dress-down or Spirit days may be approved by the Principal.
