CSS Definitions

- **School Climate:** Composite score of items related to school, home/community, personal development, and school operations and written from a whole-child perspective – high validity and high reliability
- **School Satisfaction:** Composite score of items related to satisfaction with our school system— high validity and high reliability for both students and teachers.

Student Satisfaction Items:

- I am very satisfied with my school.
- I would rather go to this school than any other school.
- I am very satisfied with JCPS.

Certified Staff Satisfaction Items:

- I am satisfied with my position at JCPS.
- I would recommend JCPS as a good place to work.
- I am satisfied with my department/work place.
- I would rather send my own child(ren) to JCPS than to a non-JCPS school.
- I am very satisfied with JCPS.

CSS Correlations

- High School
 - Correlation = .81, $p < .01$ (high correlation, highly significant)
- Middle School
 - Correlation = .86, $p < .01$ (high correlation, highly significant)
- Elementary School
 - Correlation = .55, $p < .01$ (medium correlation, highly significant)

Operationalization of Growth Analysis

- Original survey was on Likert-type four-point scale
- Averages were transformed to Stanines (type of standard score)
- Stanines range from 1 to 9: Stanines 1-3 are below or in need of improvement; Stanines 4-6 are average or good; Stanines 7-9 are above or excellent
- Years used were the 2008 baseline vs. school year 2010
- Color-coding of changes over time (shades of green, yellow, and red)

STUDENTS - Analysis of Progress and Opportunities for Growth

School Climate:

- *Elementary schools* have made progress in school climate, particularly as related to the survey sections on (a) school (e.g., school is fun, joy of going to school, talking about events in the news with teachers, safety) and (b) home/community (e.g., recycling, saving energy). More students have computer and Internet access at home. There is an opportunity for growth on the survey sections related to (a) personal development (e.g., eating breakfast, physical exercise) and (b) school operations (e.g., using math outside of school, decreasing class size, more helpful books).
- *Middle schools* have made progress in most areas of the school climate survey, except for participation in sport teams and clubs/activities sponsored by schools. In the home/community section, it was observed a major gain in civic-related items (i.e., I would contact a public official about an issue of concern, I routinely reuse and recycle everything that I can). Particularly interesting gains were observed in the sections related to (a) school (e.g., teachers respecting students' opinions, teachers caring for students, talking with counselors/deans); (b) personal development (e.g., finding answers to problems, telling the truth); and, (c) school operations (e.g., effective leadership, teachers enjoying teaching, individual attention from teachers, talking about school progress, community service).
- *High schools* have made progress in most areas of the school climate survey, except for participation in sport teams and clubs/activities sponsored by schools. In the home/community section, it was observed a major gain in civic-related items (i.e., I would contact a public official about an issue of concern, I routinely reuse and recycle everything that I can). Observable gains were related to (a) school (e.g., school is fun and challenging, feeling part of the school community, teachers respecting students' opinions, teachers caring for students, talking with counselors/deans, safety); (b) personal development (e.g., knowing how to disagree without starting a fight, telling the truth); and, (c) school operations (e.g., effective leadership, academically challenging content, teachers enjoying teaching, individual attention from teachers, talking about school progress, engaging in science experiments, community service, enjoying meals at school).

Student Satisfaction:

- *Elementary schools* have a 1% increase in students' satisfaction when compared to the baseline year (86.4% vs. 85.4%, respectively).
- *Middle schools* have a 2.1% increase on levels of students' satisfaction when compared to the baseline year (72.1% vs. 70%, respectively).
- *High schools* have a 3.1% increase in students' satisfaction when compared to the baseline year (71.2% vs. 68.1%, respectively)

CERTIFIED STAFF - Analysis of Progress and Opportunities for Growth

School Climate:

- *Certified staff* have made progress in most areas and items of the school climate survey.
- In the students' section, certified staff have a 4.2% increase when compared to the baseline year (85.6% vs. 81.3%, respectively). In particular, it was observed a major gain in several items (i.e., caring for students, students participating in school-sponsored sport teams and clubs/activities).
- In the school operation section, certified staff have a 1.2% increase when compared to the baseline year (87.9% vs. 86.7%, respectively). Notable gains were observed on items related to (a) teaching discussion skills in classes and (b) providing learning activities in a way that enhances student learning. There is room for growth on leadership support by (a) central office and (b) Site-Based Decision-Making councils.
- In the employee section, certified staff have a 2.9% increase when compared to the baseline year (88.2% vs. 85.3%, respectively). There is room for growth on (a) contacting public officials about issues of concern and (b) exercising on a regular basis.

Certified Staff Satisfaction:

- *Certified staff* have a 2.61% increase in their satisfaction when compared to the baseline year (91.7% vs. 89.1%, respectively).
