

The 2012 Russell Garth Leadership Award

Purpose

The purpose of the *Russell Garth Leadership Award* is to recognize the Jefferson County Public School Principal each year who best represents the qualities of leadership; dedication to students, staff and school; and outreach to the community.

Guidelines

1. The Selection Committee will be composed of members of the Board of Directors of the Jefferson County Public Education Foundation along with two individuals with relevant expertise such as a retired principal or higher education faculty member.
2. The Selection Committee will meet in the spring of each year to review and action plan for the selection process.
3. The nominees submitted must be current Jefferson County Public School Principals at the Elementary, Middle or High School level and have served a minimum of 10 years as an employee with Jefferson County Public Schools. Candidates may be self-nominated or submitted by a nominator.
4. Nomination forms will be distributed online to principals and administrators and available through the Jefferson County Public Education Foundation office at Jaeger Education Center, 502 Wood Road, Suite 201. Applications must be received at the Jefferson County Public Education Foundation office postmarked by May 27, 2012.
5. The Selection Committee will convene after May 27, 2012 to review the documentation of the nominees and to recommend an award recipient.

3. Outreach to Community (Indicators may include participation/membership in local community events; promotion of school and district; and partnerships with organizations/businesses).
