

Okolona Elementary School-Based Decision Making Uniform Policy

Pants, slacks, skirts, jumpers or shorts must be:

- khaki, navy or black
- longer than two (2) inches above the knee
- logo-free

Jeans (*denim*) may be worn on announced uniform-free days **only**.

Shirts must be:

- polo-style, regular collar, button-down collar or turtleneck collar in any solid color
- short or long sleeved
- solid color or have an Okolona Elementary logo

Sweaters/Sweatshirts must be:

- white, navy, black (*solid color*) or have an Okolona Elementary logo
- pullover or cardigan style with collared shirt underneath

Shoes must be:

- tied or properly fastened at all times
- closed toe and closed heel shoes

Athletic/tennis shoes are preferred. Flip-flops are **not** permitted.

General:

- Oversized clothing may **not** be worn.
- A belt must be worn if pants are loose fitting.
- Unnatural hair coloring (*blue, pink, green, etc.*) are distracting and are **not** permitted.

The following actions will take place for students not in compliance with the uniform policy:

- A phone call will be made to request proper uniform attire be brought to school.
- Uniform components will be provided for the school day by the Family Resource Center and must be returned the following day.
- A reminder will be sent to parents/guardians about our uniform policy if parents/guardians cannot be reached by phone.

Principal or designee will have final authority in decisions regarding uniforms.
