What is the Family Resource Center?

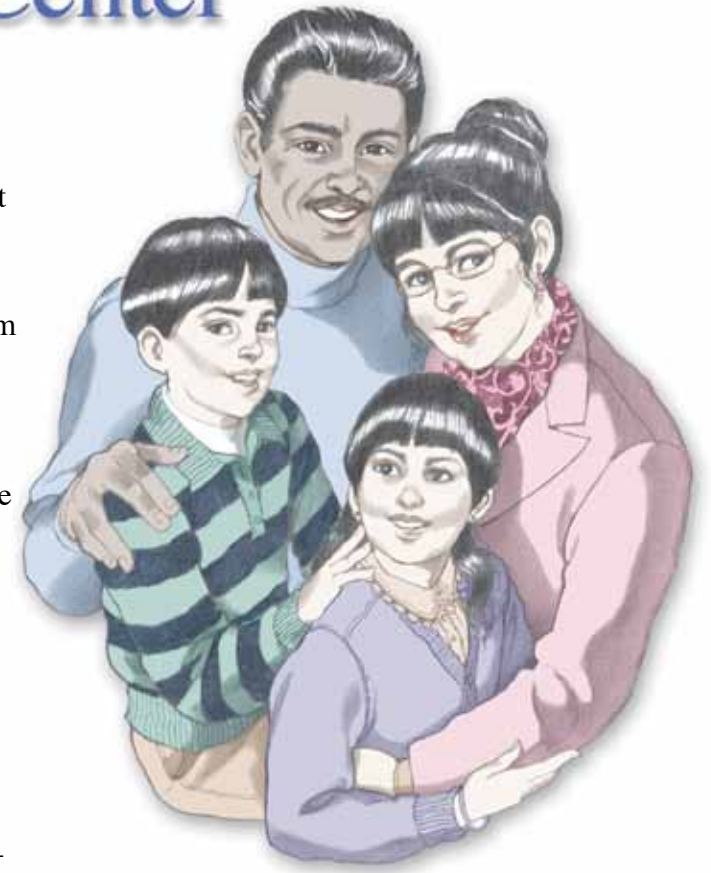
Family Resource Centers were created as a part of the 1990 Kentucky Education Reform Act (KERA). These centers are designed to assist in removing barriers that prevent children from learning and to provide services to help students succeed in school. This is accomplished by linking families to agencies in the community or by providing community services at the centers.

Who operates the Family Resource Center?

The center is staffed by a coordinator and a clerk. It is overseen by an Advisory Council that is made up of parents/caregivers, community members, and school staff. For more information, or if you would like to be an Advisory Council member, please contact the center at 485-6194.
