School Meal Prices

For elementary school students, lunch costs \$2.30. For middle and high school students, lunch costs \$2.40. Breakfast is available at most schools, and it costs \$1.75 for elementary school students and \$1.85 for middle and high school students. À la carte milk is 35 cents. Also, schools offer free and reduced prices for breakfast and lunch to students who qualify based on USDA guidelines.*

Many schools offer an à la carte program. JCPS School and Community Nutrition Services will notify parents/guardians about meal prices and payment options by U.S. Mail. This information is also available through your child's school or at www.jcpsky.net/departments/nutritionservices/index.html.
